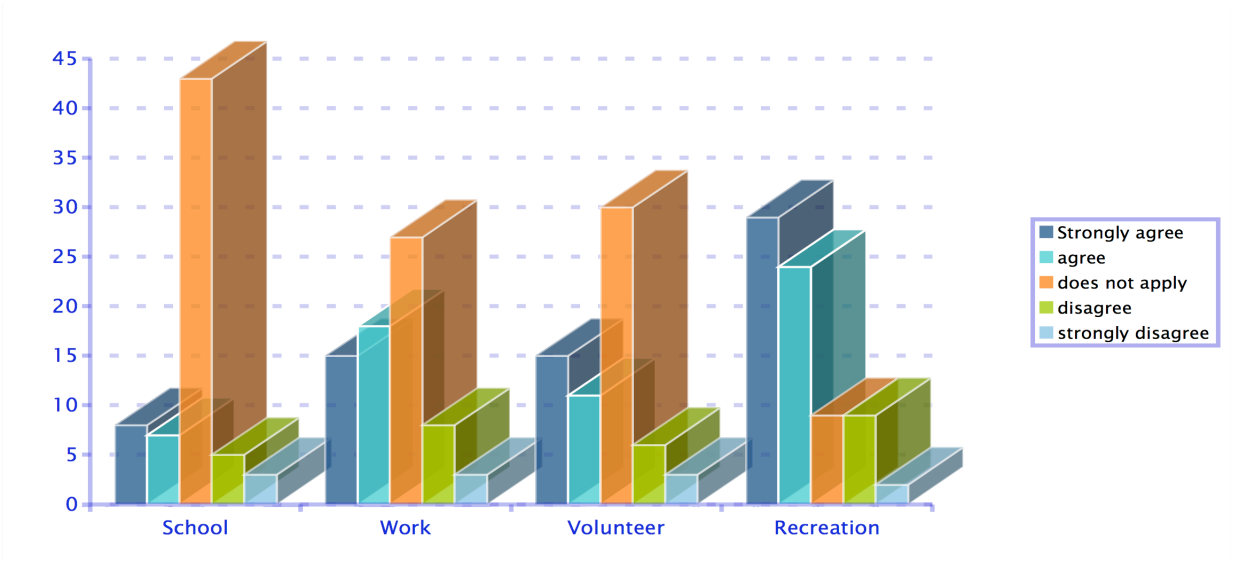
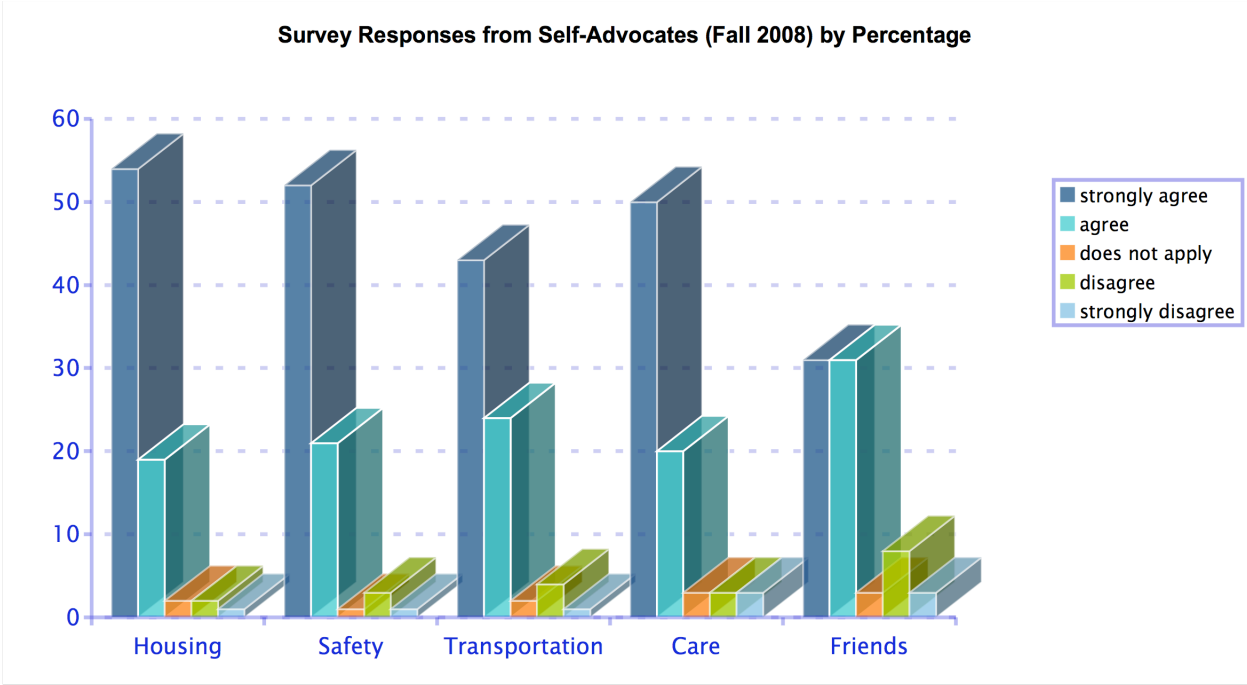


# CLBC Surrey Community Council Survey Results: Supporting Adult Responses Fall 2008
